


WAGGGS Friendship Knot


A friendship knot symbolizes the bond of friendship and is the symbol of the World Association of Girl Guides and Girl Scouts (WAGGGS). It is a square shape made up of alternating colors. It can be used to tie neckerchiefs or be given away as SWAPS.




Materials:

- Ribbon or Scarf
- Safety pin (for SWAPS)


Friendship Knot Instructions




1 Cross the straps and pass the blue end under the red one




2 Take the red strap end down



3 Take the blue end to the right forming a "Z"




4 Pass the red end up through the blue angular loop



5 Hold and pull the ends to tighten

6 The knot is made



This knot represents all members of WAGGGS and is a sign of the continuous friendship they share.

The four ends represent the Promise, Law, Motto & Service, and the four squares in the center represent the four World Centres.
